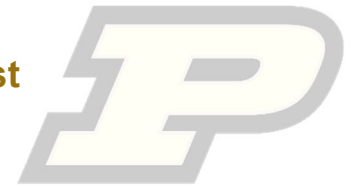

- Minimum of 90 graduate course and research credit hours (including at most 30 credit hours from the Master's degree, required for both PhD and Direct-PhD).
 - Nine credit hours of Math (as least 6 credit hours must come from the Math Dept., the remaining 3 credit hours can be from the approved applied mathematics list).
 - At least one 600-level course
- PhD: Minimum of 21 credit hours of coursework beyond the Master's degree required.
- Direct-PhD: Minimum of 36 credit hours of coursework required.
