
Call for Nominations: Estus H. and Vashti L. Magoon Award

The Purdue University College of Engineering Magoon Awards are given to outstanding teaching assistants and instructors in memory of Estus H. and Vashti L. Magoon, who have influenced the lives of many engineering educators through this award. The award is made possible through the generous Estus H. and Vashti L. Magoon endowment and is managed by the CoE Graduate Engineering Office. Mechanical Engineering is allowed to nominate 6 students.

Award amount:

Each Magoon Awardee will receive \$2,000, a certificate, recognition at the annual awards luncheon, and in a video produced specifically for this event.

Eligibility:

Nominees must:

- Be enrolled in an engineering M.S. or Ph.D. program, in good standing, and have held a **half-time or more** appointment as a graduate instructor or graduate teaching assistant for at least one semester in the **2022 calendar year**. (*Note: Students are only eligible to be nominated from the department where they hold their assistantship.*)
- The half-time appointment must have included a minimum of .25 FTE contact teaching (lecture, recitation, lab).

Nomination Package shall contain:

For each nominee, please combine into one .pdf the following documents:

- Cover sheet containing all required information about the nominee– name (Last, First, MI), name to appear on certificate if selected, PUID, Purdue student email, if student is international or domestic, gender of student, date of birth (mm/dd/yyyy), local address, and permanent address
- Summary of Teaching Assignments during 2022 Calendar Year
- Confirmation of Teaching Contact in excess of .25 FTE
- Recommendation from TA-assigned course instructor
- Teaching Evaluations
