

## Call for Nominations: Outstanding Service Scholarship

### Due: Deadline as posted on ME Grad Blog

The Purdue University College of Engineering Outstanding Service Scholarship Award recognizes engineering graduate students who provide outstanding service to the graduate student community, the School, the College, and /or the University. We ask each School to nominate one candidate for the Outstanding Service Scholarship. The award is sponsored and managed by the CoE Graduate Education Office.

### Award amount:

One Outstanding Service Scholarship awardee per school will receive \$2,000, a certificate, recognition at the annual awards luncheon, and recognition in a video produced specifically for this event.

### Eligibility:

Nominees must:

- Be enrolled as a graduate student pursuing a Master's or Ph.D. degree in your school.
- Be in good academic standing with a minimum GPA of 3.0, with a higher GPA preferred.
- Have completed at least one full calendar year in your graduate program at the time of the nomination.
- Have contributed over time to the quality, reputation, or success of the graduate student community, School, College, and/or University.

### Nomination Process:

Each nomination will consist of:

A letter from the Head of the School or the Chair of the Graduate Committee, identifying the School's nominee and describing the process used to select the nominee within the School--***If selected as ME's nominee, this will be added to the nomination package before submission to the college.***

Cover sheet containing all required information about the nominee- name (Last, First, MI), name to appear on certificate if selected, PUID, Purdue student email, if student is international or domestic, gender of student, date of birth (mm/dd/yyyy), local address, and permanent address;

A letter from the student's major professor recommending the student should be selected for the Outstanding Service Scholarship and includes factual information demonstrating how the student has contributed over time to the quality, reputation, or success of the graduate student community, School, College, and/or University.
