

Hommert Engineering Excellence Fellowship Announcement

The School of Mechanical Engineering awards the Hommert Engineering Excellence Fellowship annually to an outstanding female graduate student enrolled in Mechanical Engineering who has provided excellent service to the School or Purdue community. This fellowship is funded from the estate of Paul and Elizabeth Hommert. Dr. Hommert is a Mechanical Engineering Outstanding Alumnus and Director Emeritus of Sandia National Laboratories. The recipient will receive a one-time scholarship of \$2,500.

Applicants should meet the following criteria:

1. Be pursuing a graduate degree (M.S. or Ph.D.) in ME.
2. Be among the top academic performers in the school (not necessarily have a 4.0 GPA).
3. Have contributed over time to the quality, reputation, network, or success of engineering graduate women community.

Application will consist of:

- A resume.
- An essay from the student to describe her leadership, service experience or other significant involvement to help increase gender diversity and representation in engineering.
- A letter from ME faculty containing detailed information that shows how the student meets each of the three criteria listed above.
