

Purdue MRI Facility Publication Policy

Expectations for authorship for Purdue MRI Facility personnel will be discussed with initial contact. While authorship is not required and will often be inappropriate for personnel providing research input to the project (particularly assisting in adapting work to the MRI environment), if there is significant intellectual and/or organizational effort (e.g., serving as primary operator throughout the data collection) on the part of Purdue MRI Facility personnel to the work described in the manuscript, authorship is warranted and expected. For example, expert data analysis from Purdue MRI Facility personnel that is required in support of claims in a manuscript or patent warrant authorship. It will be made clear to investigators utilizing the Purdue MRI Facility that the recovery of Purdue MRI Facility expenses through billing does not exclude the possibility for authorship for research personnel. Similarly, authorship does not substitute for payment of Purdue MRI Facility expenses for services rendered.

In publications that describe research that took place at the Purdue MRI Facility, authors should identify such as the location of the specific MRI system utilized, or acknowledge the use of the specific Facility (Small Animal, Life Sciences, or Engineering MRI Facility) and either (1) the Weldon School of Biomedical Engineering for the Small Animal, (2) College of Health and Human Sciences for the Life Science, and College of Engineering for the Engineering MRI Facility:

"The author(s) acknowledge the use of the <Insert Specific MRI Facility>, administered by the <Insert Specific College/School Here>, a core facility of the NIH-funded Indiana Clinical & Translational Science Institute (IndianaCTSI)."
