The prestigious Neil Armstrong Distinguished Visiting Professors program brings highly accomplished and recognized scholars and practitioners of engineering to catalyze collaborations with faculty and students. They are preeminent in their fields and are typically Fellows of the US National Academies of Science, Engineering, and Medicine.

During their visits, the scholars collaborate with Purdue Engineering faculty on research projects and/or broader School or College priorities, including new research directions, industry engagement, on-campus and online educational efforts, increasing diversity and inclusion as well as entrepreneurship. Their appointments are at a maximum of three months and can be undertaken over the course of multiple visits, which must be completed within three years.
