- 33T Update
  - 33T is back up flying! Please avoid maneuvers that are rough on the engine within its first 10 hours.
- 47G G5 Upgrade Plans
  - Vote Results: More in favor of an upgrade in early August (earliest time available) than in October
- CO2 Detector in 33T expires soon so we will be replacing all 3 of the CO2 detectors at the same time in each of our planes
- Discussion on ADS-B
  - We will be getting the ADS-B in 33T in October of this year
  - 11942 ADS-B is a split issue- only 16 responses on emailed survey
    - Without ADS-B no Class C or 30 nm of Class B airfields or above 10,000 ft. (Chicago, Cincinnati, KIND, KCMJ etc.)
    - Purdue Aviation is getting ADS-B in their Cessna 152s.
    - We can potentially get an ADS-B with a skybeacon for \$2,300 instead of the original estimation of \$5,500
    - This will be a continued topic of discussion going into the fall semester after we evaluate our finances following summer flying
