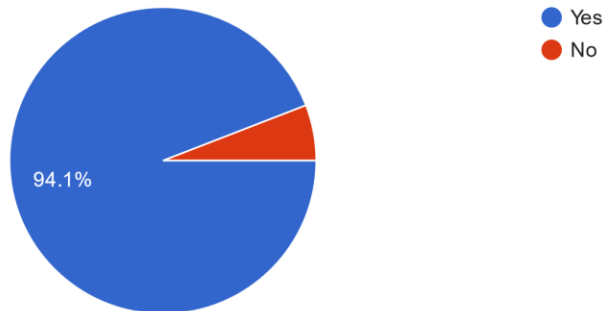

The aspen e5s are a nightmare, just walk over to hangar 6 and they'll tell you about it

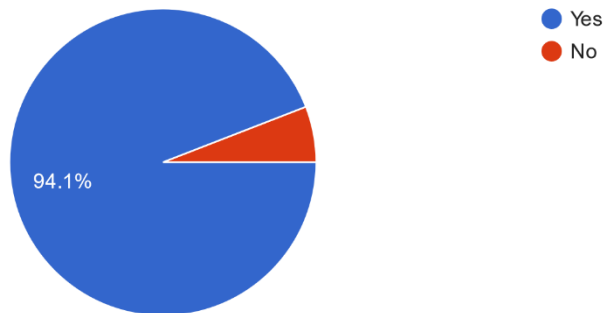
Do you agree with the decision to keep the dues and rates the same for the Summer 2021 semester?

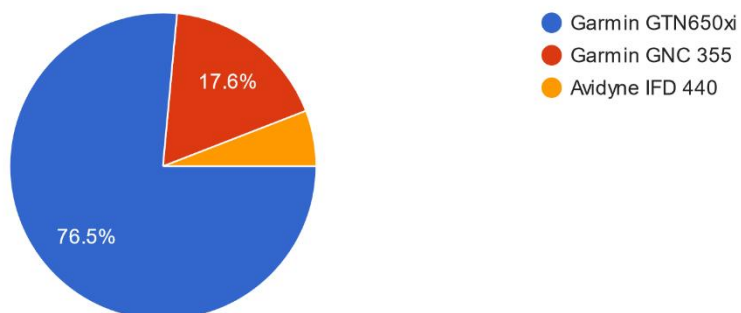
Do you agree with the proposed "Grace Period" for the payment of dues?

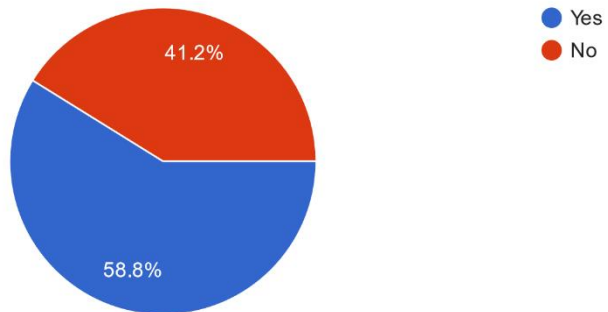


GPS Selection for 33T
