WHAT YOU'LL DO

- Maintain inventories of chemicals, equipment, laboratory materials, and supplies.
- Assist with safety documentation and routine laboratory safety operations.
- Sort, clean, and organize laboratory materials and supplies.
- Help maintain laboratory refrigerators and freezers.

WHAT YOU'LL GAIN

- In-depth chemical laboratory safety training and certification; all required PPE will be provided.
- Firsthand experience with the infrastructure of an Environmental Engineering research facility.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- Willingness and ability to safely handle closed containers of hazardous chemicals, including acutely toxic, flammable, and corrosive materials, following required procedures.
- Excellent focus and attention to detail.
- Ability to handle fragile items with care.
- Access to a laptop for inventory work.

BONUS, NOT REQUIRED: Ability to occasionally lift or move items weighing 10-20 kg (22-44 lb).
