Anne Dare (PhD ABE 2014) is on a non-traditional path for an engineer. After participating in the Christine Mirzayan Science & Technology Policy Graduate Fellowship at the National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine, and subsequently as AAAS Science & Technology Policy Fellow at the U.S. Agency for International Development, she is embarking on a career at the intersection of science and diplomacy. Building on a research background in reclaimed water use in the Middle East and North Africa, she consults on strategy and planning for water management in the region, and supports a program that provides research grants for Israeli and Arab scientists to cooperate on transboundary scientific issues.

Anne will share her experience with science diplomacy, and pathways for scientists and engineers to work in public policy.
