Dr. Ron Hann, a member of the Senior Executive Service (SES), is the Director, Chemical/Biological Technologies Department (CB) for the Defense Threat Reduction Agency (DTRA). In this position he leads, directs, and is the focal point for all DTRA Chemical and Biological Defense (CBD) Science and Technology (S&T) programs and guides the strategic, scientific, and technological goals of DTRA’s CBD S&T research efforts. He is dual-hatted as the head of the Joint Science and Technology Office for Chemical and Biological Defense (JSTO-CBD) under the DoD Chemical and Biological Defense Program (CBDP).

Dr. Hann was promoted to the SES in April 2014 following his retirement from the U.S. Army Chemical Corps after almost 27 years of active duty. Prior to his current assignment, he was the Acting Director of CB. His first military tour with DTRA was in 2002 where he was assigned as a Mission Commander to the Chemical and Biological Division, On-Site Inspection Directorate. Following that tour, he earned a doctorate in Organic Synthesis from the University of Virginia; then taught Organic Chemistry at the U.S. Military Academy at West Point.

In addition to Dr. Hann’s Ph.D. in Organic Chemistry from the University of Virginia, he holds both B.S. and M.A. degrees in Chemistry from the College of William and Mary in Williamsburg, Virginia.
