- WHEN:** 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. on Saturday, April 11, 2026

- WHY:** Opportunity to practice and demonstrate teaming, creativity, problem solving and engineering design skills
- HOW:** Three-to-four person teams will address a given engineering problem using methodology learned in ENGR 13X or ENGR 16X courses

ABOUT THE COMPETITION

Who can participate: All students enrolled in FYE, including students enrolled in any FYE pathway: ENGR 13000, ENGR 13100 / 13200, Honors, EPICS and VIP.

Judging panel: A subset of 15-20 teams will be selected to compete in the in-person portion of this competition (Rounds 2 and 3) during which they will present designs to a 12-person judging panel of graduate students, industry professionals and Purdue faculty.
