How to join?

The great news about BMES is once you're admitted into the Purdue BME program, you are automatically granted general access to our events.

However, official membership is available to undergraduates of all majors and includes many more benefits with a few simple steps:

1. Fill out a short official sign-up form
2. Pay dues
 - a. \$20 annual fee

Committee Structure

Every committee consists of a Committee Director, Committee Chair, a WL Sophomore Representative, and an Indianapolis Liaison. You work as a team, but each have designated roles.

Committee Director:

- Head of Committee
- Delegates relevant committee tasks
- Works with internal and external resources for team goals
- Keeps track of committee goals

Committee Chair:

- Serves in place of director when needed
- Documents event preparation
- Completes relevant tasks
- Identifies areas of growth in the committee

(WL) Sophomore Representative:

- Learns day to day operations and skills from director and chair
- Supports committee event planning
- Advocates for Sophomore class and their best interest
- Identifies areas of growth in the committee

Indianapolis Liaison:

- Learns day to day operations and skills from director and chair
- Supports committee event planning
- Advocates for Indianapolis campus and their BME students' best interest
- Identifies areas of growth in the committee

BMES Election FAQ

- You may apply for a maximum of two positions
- Vice President compiles your application and the rest of the BMES board votes
- Applications are open from **November 4th to November 15th**
 - Will send out private decisions after November 20th
 - Following acceptance of positions, they will be publicly announced the first week of the spring semester

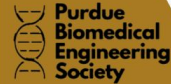

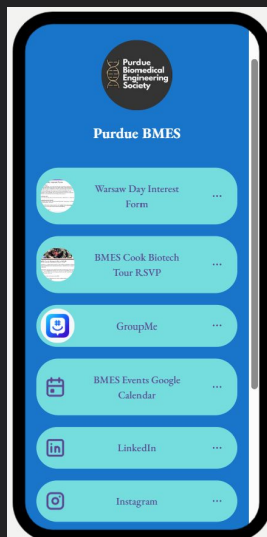
