Overview

- Students will have class each weekday (evenings and weekends free)

Eligibility

Prerequisites: You must have successfully completed 1 course from each of the four categories listed prior to the start of the program:

1. ENGR 13100 or ENGR 14100 or ENGR 16100 or ENGR 13300
2. PHYS 17200 or PHYS 15200 or (ENGR 16100 and ENGR 16200)
3. MA 16600 (minimum grade C-) or MA 16200 (minimum grade C-)
4. MA 26100 or MA 17400 or MA 18200 or MA 27101

Travel Overseas

Students will depart the USA May 10, arriving May 11. Orientation on May 12, class begins on May 13. Final exam will be on June 5 and you are free to leave anytime after (Housing check out: 10am on June 6)
