Our seminar will be dedicated to two important aspects of safety training for civil engineering students.

- Karen Hatke, Program Coordinator for the Joint Transportation Research Program (JTRP) here in Civil, will present roadside safety training that describes appropriate equipment and procedures for working along highways.
- Don Campbell, Safety Engineer with Purdue's Radiological and Environmental Management Department, will provide fall prevention training, which will address safe practices and equipment while working from structures such as bridges or tall buildings.
