- Ideas for DEI:

 - Potential issue: Maintaining civil discourse on anonymous boards could be a challenge.
 - Have a roundtable peer-to-peer discussion amongst grad students.
 - Point of consideration: A moderator may be required to ensure the discussion remains civil and on topic.
 - Discussion amongst peers may be more open.
 - Invite an expert (Dr. Evans, Ph.D Associate Dean of Students, Education and Advocacy) to nucleate discussion.
 - An expert could provide suggestions for improving DEI in the dept.
 - Discussion may be stifled in the presence of an authority figure.
 - Alternatively, all three of the above ideas can be implemented in a step-by-step manner considering feedback from students at each level.
