***** Definitions

- Standard: something established by authority, custom, or general consent as a model or example: <u>CRITERION</u>
 4: something set up and established by authority as a rule for the measure of quantity, weight, extent, value, or quality
- Specifications: 2 a: a detailed precise presentation of something or of a plan or proposal for something -- usually used in plural b: a statement of legal particulars (as of charges or of contract terms)

* Purpose

- Efficiency
- Define an expectation level (Set the Rules)

- * Identify the Process Used for Creating a List
- * How will Implementation be Achieved

Keep in Mind:

All written requirements have at least one thing in common ... cost (to both buyer and seller).



Group or Categorize

- Subjective Measures Used During Evaluation
- Outdated (ex: Methodologies No Longer Used)
- No Data Currently Being Collected
- Non-Uniform Enforcement
- Potential Impact to Product
