RESPONSIBILITIES:

The incumbent will set up and manage a new trace contaminant lab funded by major Purdue University Discovery Park centers, analyze trace compounds occurring in advanced life support for space missions and volatile organic compounds emitted by agricultural operations, manage and operate an existing olfactometry laboratory, mentor graduate students, and manage research projects. The position involves close collaboration with other scientists and engineers on and off campus, data processing and interpretation, development of analytical methodologies, publications, and draft proposals.
