Congratulations! The School of Electrical and Computer Engineering is pleased to offer you the **Bilsland Dissertation Fellowship**.

In recognition of your outstanding academic achievements, this fellowship provides **one semester** of graduate school support and is being administered as a **half-time (0.5 FTE) Fiscal Year assistantship**. You are expected to devote approximately 20 hours per week to the completion of all doctoral degree requirements and to receive your doctoral degree at the completion of the award tenure. Your supervisor will be Prof. Shalaev.

This fellowship is not renewable. If you receive your degree prior to the completion of this award, you will forfeit any remaining funds. You must register full time, a minimum of 8 credits for Fall/Spring Semester and a minimum of 6 credits for Summer Session. Bilsland Dissertation Fellows cannot register as Degree Only.

The **Bilsland Fellowship** provides the following compensation and benefits for the **Fall semester: August 16, 2021 – December 24, 2021**.

- Base salary from the Graduate School of **\$7,450.00** for the fiscal year, paid in bi-weekly increments.
- An annual medical insurance premium contribution, the value of which is currently estimated at \$593.00 per semester, to cover a portion of the total cost of your medical insurance.
- The **Bilsland Fellowship** will pay the following student fees (amounts listed are for the current academic year and are subject to change):
 - Repair and Rehabilitation fee - \$161.00 Fall, Spring; \$80.50 Summer session
 - Student Fitness & Wellness Fee - \$117.00 Fall, Spring; \$58.50 Summer session
 - Student Activity Fee - \$20.00 Fall, Spring; \$10.00 Summer session
 - International Student Fee (if applicable) – \$80.00 Fall, Spring, Summer
- A College Differential Fee, currently \$562.00, is charged to engineering students at the beginning of each semester. This fee will be your responsibility.
- A graduate tuition remission, currently valued at **\$14,004.90** for the semester, is provided to cover your tuition costs.

Award Guarantee:

- This offer is contingent upon submitting proof of your identity and eligibility to work in the United States. Purdue University utilizes an online onboarding system through which you will complete new hire electronic documents, including the electronic Section 1 of the USCIS **Form I-9, Employment Eligibility Verification**. Section 1 must be completed **no later** than your start date.
- A Welcome email will be sent to you from **Purdue HR** and will contain the link and information needed to log into your employee dashboard where you will complete your electronic documents. Section 2 of the electronic I-9 must be completed no later than the 3rd business day after your start date and requires you to **physically present original and unexpired document(s)** from the **List of Acceptable Documents** found at <https://www.uscis.gov/i-9-central/acceptable-documents>. Another communication will notify you where to go on campus to complete section 2 in person.
- Ensure you have set up a bank account and recorded it through your account in **both** myPurdue and OnePurdue.
- Be enrolled and maintain status as a full-time graduate student in the degree-granting graduate program at Purdue to which you were admitted. You will not receive funding for any pay period in which you are not registered and enrolled as a full-time student.
- Maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA. Fulfill all academic milestones as outlined by this program.
- Report all other financial awards, such as NSF, NDSEG, SMART, NIH, etc., to your graduate administrator. This award cannot be held simultaneously with any other award providing full support.
- Adhere to all applicable university policies and maintain ethical behavior regarding all academic practices and work performed.
